Grading Basis: Pass/Fail

Term Typically Offered: Fall, Spring

Description: This course supports non-degree seeking Fellowships or Visiting Scholar positions in various areas of dentistry. These fellowships may take the form of post-residency training, or may be individuals participating in short or long term projects for a period of time past their dental school training. Individuals may participate in selected teaching, clinical, observational or research activities. Selection is made by individual department heads or program directors on a case-by case basis.
