Accelerated BS Business Economics to MS Business Analytics

Exceptional majors the BS Business Economic degree tracks may apply to earn up to 9 graduate-level credit hours during their senior year that are counted towards both the BS and MS in Business Analytics degrees, allowing students to go on and complete the graduate degree with the remaining graduate hours, saving both time and expense.

Undergraduate students interested in participating in an accelerated dual bachelor's/ master's degree offered through the Soaring Scholar (https://graduate.louisville.edu/academics/programs/soaring/) program must first meet with their Academic Advisor and be accepted into the program. Once accepted, students will receive an official admission letter outlining program policies and details. They will then work with their department and academic advisor to register for classes each semester, ensuring they meet the milestones and academic progress requirements of the Soaring Scholar program. A Soaring Scholar student is considered an undergraduate student until their bachelor's degree is conferred. In their final undergraduate semester, they are expected to apply for admission to their respective master's program.

Departmental Admission Requirements New Students and Transfer Students

Admission to the College of Business (https://catalog.louisville.edu/undergraduate/admission/college-business/) ensures admission to the BS in Economics.

Current Students - Admission in Good Standing

Students must have both:

- Earned a 2.8 cumulative GPA (students with an established UofL GPA may not include grades for coursework at another institution in consideration for admission); and
- Completion of MATH 111 College Algebra QR (or equivalent) or completion of MATH 180 Elements of Calculus - QR.
