The College of Business offers a minor in management available to all UofL students. For non-business majors, a 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admittance to the program. The Management Minor prepares students to understand and navigate organizational life and how to coordinate the activities of other people in the organization. Students learn organizational behavior and human resource management, as well as other, related knowledge and skills.

For graduation, in addition to all other degree requirements, a 2.0 GPA in Management minor program core coursework and a 2.0 cumulative UofL GPA are required for graduation.
